Play with a purpose

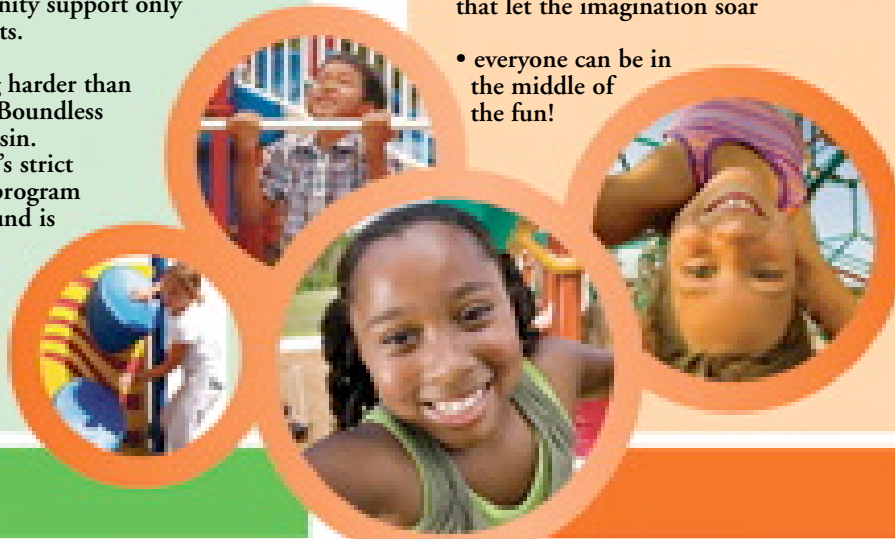
Supporters statewide are building the first fully inclusive Boundless Playground in Wisconsin for thousands of children living near or visiting Madison.

LVM Dreams Big is kicking down the physical barriers and raising a structure that opens a world of play to all children. Since forming in 2005, the committee has worked to raise funds to support the mission of improving accessibility while also promoting physical fitness and increasing safety for all children.

Reaching higher

John Lennon sang, "You may say I'm a dreamer..." but we're not the only ones. The statewide support for this project has been overwhelming. In 2007, as one of 20 finalists in the national 'Win a Boundless Playground' essay contest, we collected personal letters of support from the Governor and First Lady, State School Superintendent along with over 40 state, county and local leaders. Thousands of supporters signed our on-line letter of support at www.playgroundsupport.com. While we were disappointed that our third place finish fell just short of winning the completely accessible playground, the inspiring outpouring of community support only strengthened our efforts.

Today, we are working harder than ever to bring the first Boundless Playground to Wisconsin. Boundless Playground's strict national certification program verifies that a playground is in fact accessible to all children.
